The club participates in the hobby in a variety of ways. We get together weekly to run our model trains. In addition to fellowship at these session members bring their trains to run, or have repaired, or to just learn more about what they bought. The club will assist in repairing members' trains or converting older locomotives to a more modern way to run the locomotive via a smartphone or wireless remote control. Outside club walls, some members give tours on full size trains, discuss the importance of grade crossing safety, and all things related to railroad safety.

If your interest is model trains, our members model in all scales. The club has a 3 main line HO layout, a large O gauge layout, a 2 mainline G scale layout, and an N gauge layout which see weekly use. Additionally, club members bring their travelling HO scale modules, or standalone O, S, HO, N, and Z portable layouts to numerous public train show events. In addition to the club's enjoyment of running trains for the public, members share their knowledge of layouts, scenery tips, as well as anything that deals with full size trains, model trains, or general railroad questions.

Club members give an educational, fun, (or both) presentation that includes prototype, preservation, historical, and modelling subjects at the monthly meetings.
