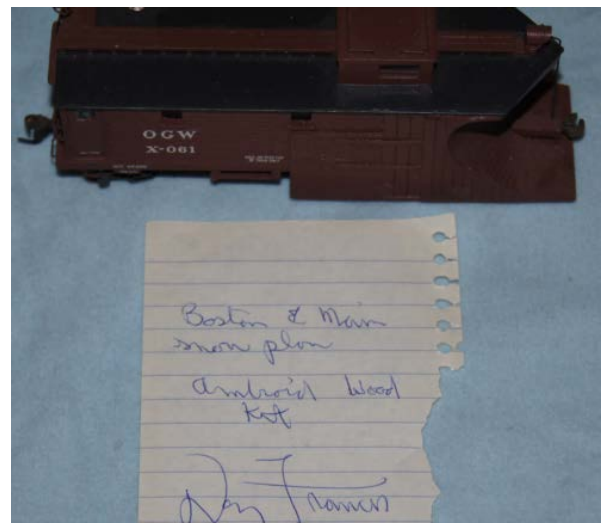
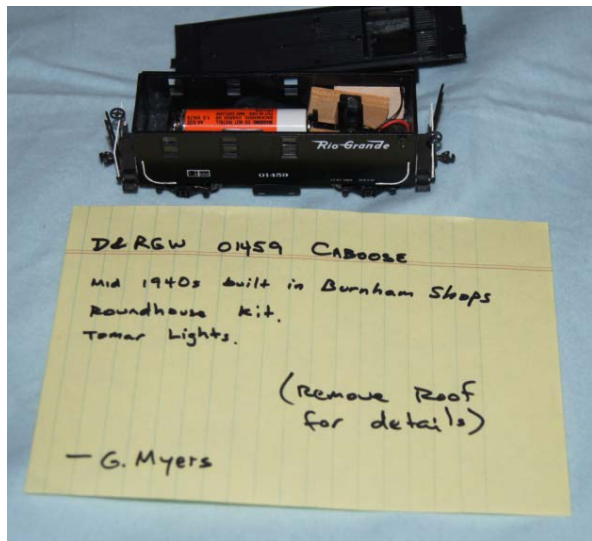


Show and Tell

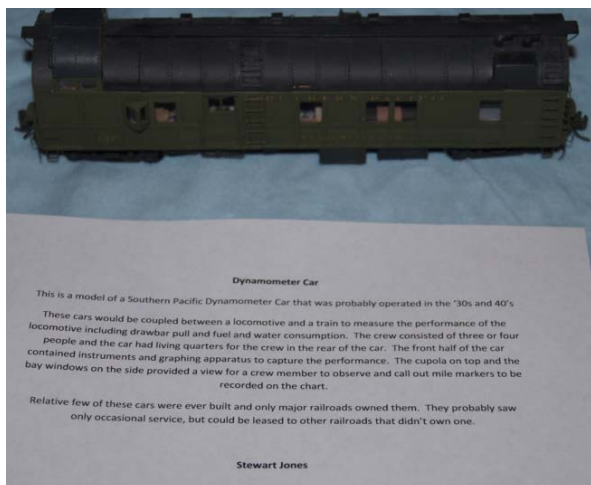
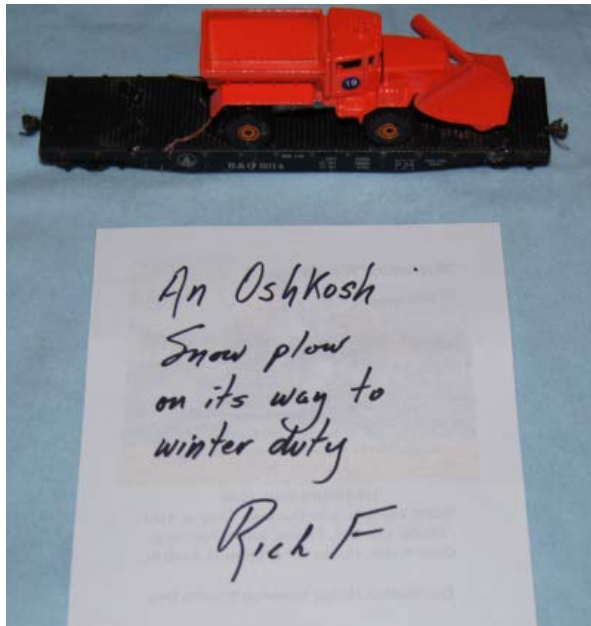
Snow & Ice/Waycars & EOT was the theme for February 2017. We had 5 submissions this month.
