Tool Time

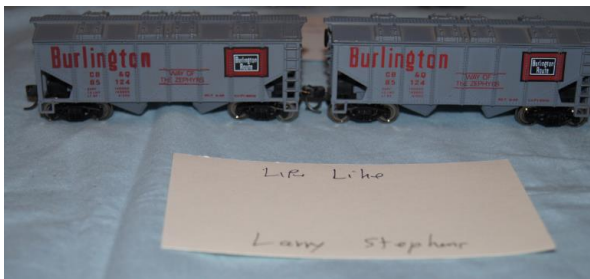
