Meeting Notes

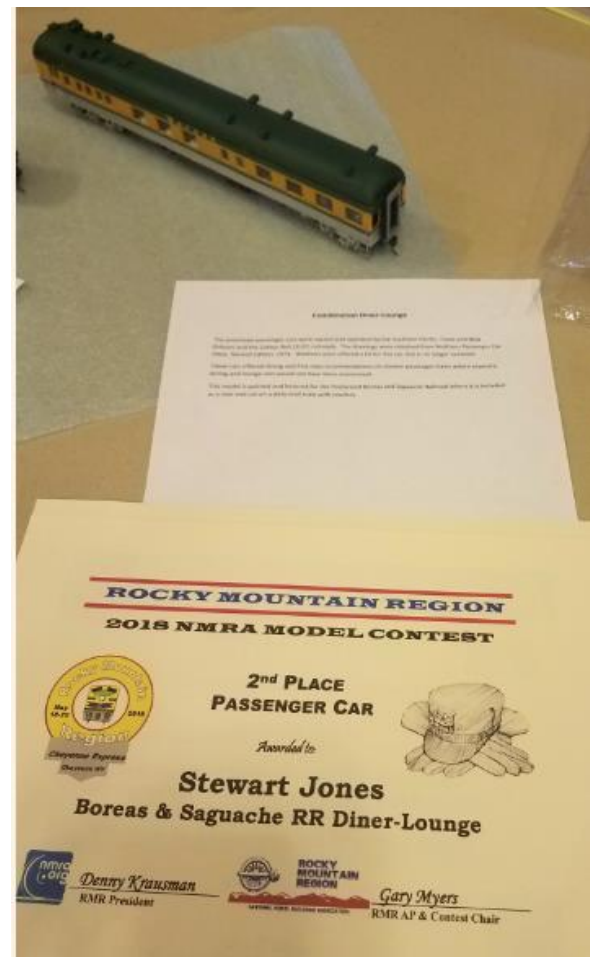
Stu called the meeting to order. We did introductions around the room, and what we, would like to see on the swap table. People would like to see detail parts and specific types of vehicles to name a few.

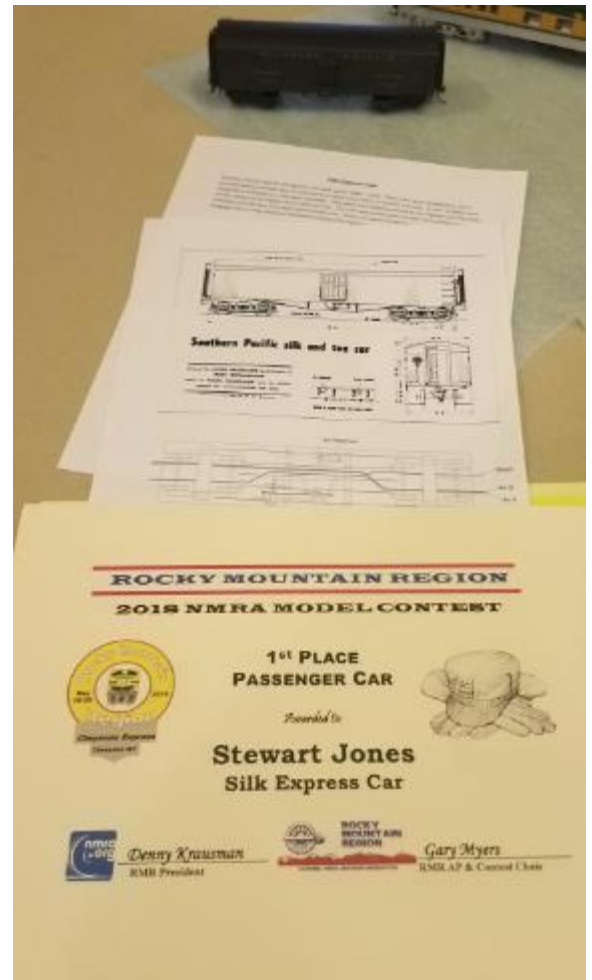

Tool Time

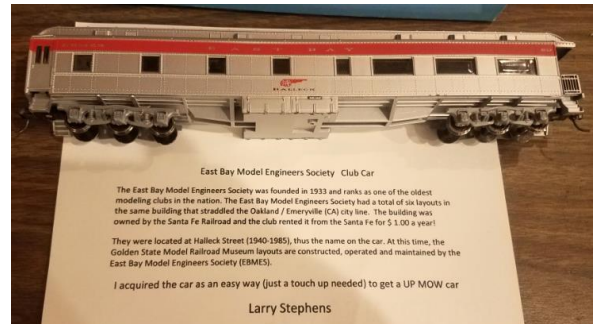

Show and Tell

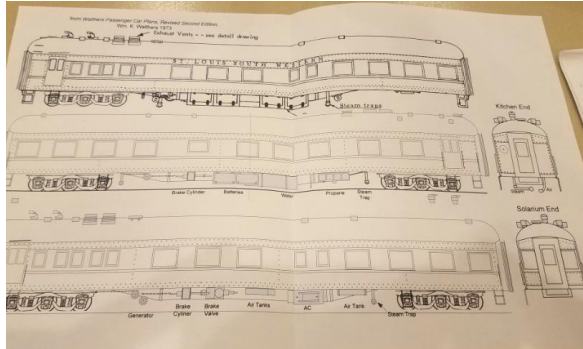
The theme was Collector / Brand Cars

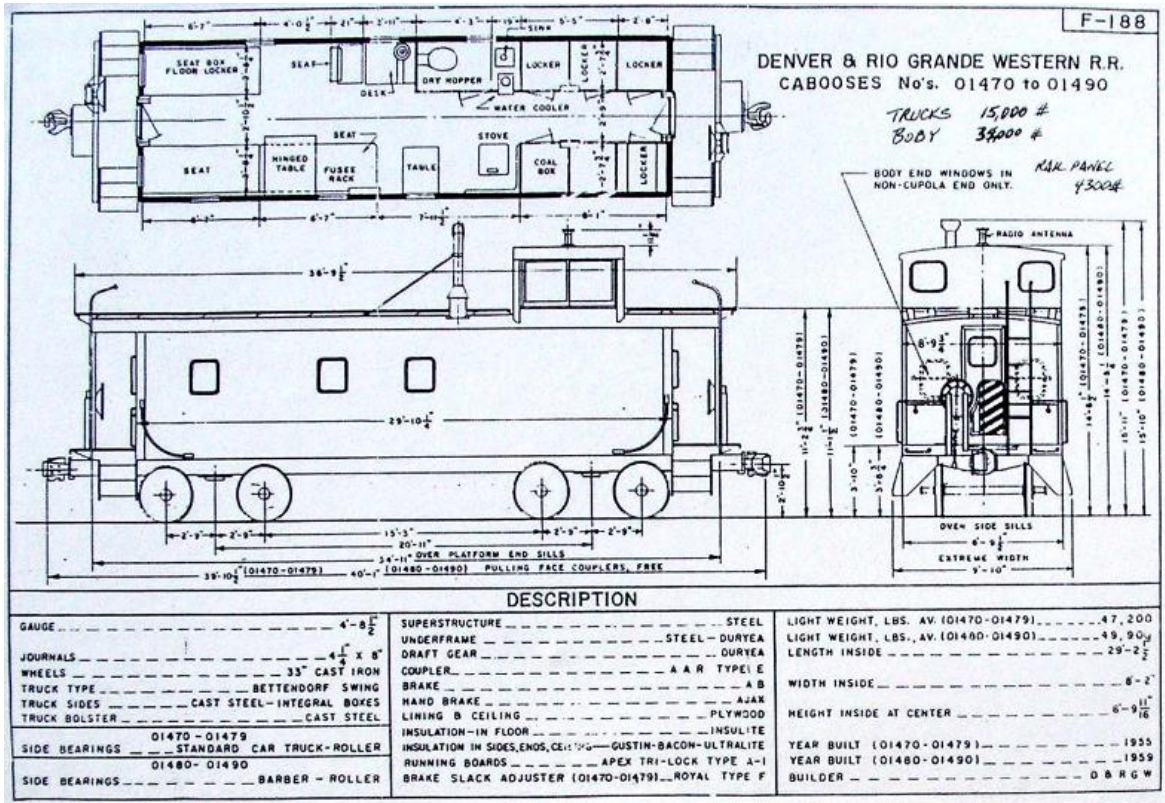
