You may recall at the November meeting that Dave Goss announced that he was disposing of the estate of an HO model railroader, including a built layout. One of our members took that layout, but Dave has since inventoried the remainder of the collection.

Thanks to Superintendent Steve and Dick Hunter, Dave has prepared an Excel spreadsheet listing more than 350 freight cars, 80+ locomotives, MOW equipment, containers and trailers, and many other pieces of rolling stock.
