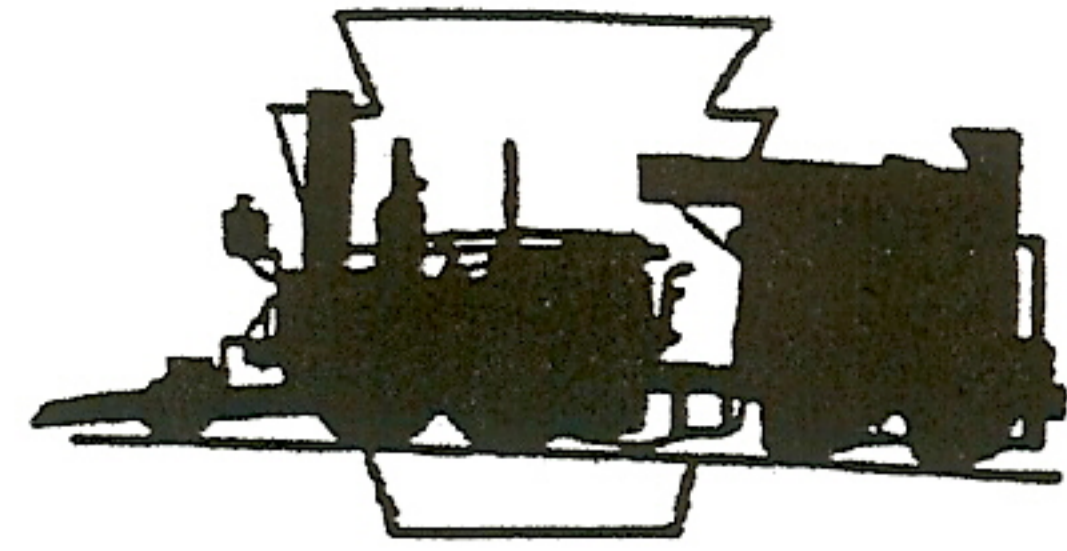


**camden & amboy railroad historical group
