# **Army Transportation Museum at Ft. Eustis:**

Heading east on I-64, take exit 250 off I-64 (Ft Eustis Blvd) and follow it right to the gate. Any driver with a military sticker on their auto, or having a military ID can get right in. If not they will have to stop and get a base pass, although last year some guys said they were let right in when they told the guard they were going to the Transportation Museum. Everyone will have to play it by ear depending on who is on the gate. Once thru the gate, go past the museum, which is on the left, and make a Uturn at the next break to come back in the outbound lanes. Use GPS or search the location on Google or MapQuest.
