Apraxia of Speech is sometimes called Verbal Apraxia of Speech or Verbal Dispraxia. No matter what name is used, the most important concept is the root word "praxis", which means "planned movement". To some degree or another, a child with the diagnosis of Apraxia of Speech has difficulty programming and planning speech movements. Apraxia of Speech is a specific speech disorder.
