Imagineering Brainstorming Rules:

(We take that one very seriously.)

Come prepared to reach for the stars as we begin to explore the possibilities.

Dreamers are encouraged and welcome for this first gathering, in future meetings we will put on our realist glasses to help refine and filter the ideas generated. Then the critics will have their chance to improve what remains.
