Western New York has a rich railroad heritage and was once the second largest rail centers in North America. In the early 20th Century, as many as 26 different railroads serviced the region, along with related industries that supported the railroad.

A "Roll of Honor" has been established to recognize the tens of thousands of men and women, living or deceased, and employees on the railroad, interurban and city street railways, and railroad related industries, who contributed so much to our Western New York Railway Heritage.
